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

**Legacy Fields**  
 Site Master Plan

Phase 1 of Legacy Fields is under construction on Tracy Boulevard just north of Interstate 205. The sports park will include 12 baseball fields and 8 soccer fields on 72 acres. Phase 1 is expected to be fully complete by late Spring 2016. This premier, regional sports and recreation center represents a \$16 million dollar commitment by the City and will ultimately provide over 166 acres of sports playing fields for the community and the region. In the future the fields might host traveling youth sports teams or regional tournaments that could bring shoppers to local restaurants, hotels, and retail stores.
