HOW TO DETERMINE ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES

(a) **Electrical Permit** – The fee for an electrical permit shall include a permit fee of **\$26.75** plus the amount shown below for each item involved in the work.

- **Lighting fixtures, brackets, pendants, cord drops, outlets, receptacles, switches, etc.**

First 20 fixtures, each	\$ 1.49
Additional fixtures, each	.97

- **Service or Service Change:**

Services not over 200 amps in rating, each	\$ 34.73
Services over 200 amps to 1,000 amps, each	70.78
Services over 1,000 amps, each	141.56
Sub-panels, each	20.73

- **Residential Appliances:**

For fixed residential appliances or receptacle outlets for same, including wall-mounted cooking tops; electric ranges; self-contained room, console or through-wall air conditioners; space heaters, food waste grinders; dishwashers; washing machines; water heaters; clothes dryers; or other motor-operated appliances not exceeding 1 horsepower (HP) in rating, each

	\$ 5.39
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- **Non-Residential Appliances:**

For non-residential appliances and self-contained factory-wired, non-residential appliances not exceeding 1 horsepower (HP), kilowatt (kW), or kilovolt-ampere (kVA), in rating including medical and dental devices; food, beverage and ice cream cabinets; illuminated show case; drinking fountains; vending machines; laundry machines; or other similar types of equipment

	\$ 5.39
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Note: For other types of air conditioners and other motor-driven appliances having larger electrical rating, see Power Apparatus.

For motors, generators, transformers, rectifiers, synchronous converters, capacitors, industrial heating, air conditioners and heat pumps, cooking or baking equipment and other apparatus as follows:

Rating in horsepower (HP), kilowatts (kW), or kilovolt-amperes-reactive (kVAR):

Up to and including 1, each	\$ 5.39
Over 1 and not over 10, each	14.00
Over 10 and not over 50, each	28.01
Over 50 and not over 100, each	56.38
Over 100, each	84.85

Notes:

1. For equipment or appliances having more than one motor, transformer, heater, etc., the sum of the ratings may be used.
2. These fees include all switches, circuit breakers, contactors, thermostats, relays and other related control equipment.

• **Signs, Outline Lighting and Marquees:**

For signs, outline lighting systems or marquees supplied from one branch circuit, each	\$ 28.01
For additional branch circuits within the same sign, outline lighting or marquee, each	5.39

• **Temporary Power Service:**

Temporary Service Pole or Pedestal, each	\$ 26.75
Temporary distribution systems and temporary lighting and receptacle outlets for construction sites, decorative lights, Christmas tree sales, etc., each	14.00

• **Carnival and Circuses:**

Carnival, circuses, or other traveling shows or exhibitions utilizing transportable-type rides, booths, displays and attractions.

For electrical generators and electrically driven rides, each	\$ 26.75
For mechanically driven rides and walk-through attractions or displays having electrical, lighting, each	8.25
For a system of area or booth lighting, each	8.25

Other Inspections and Fees: Charged at actual Employee hourly rate

1. Reinspection fees assessed under provisions of Section 305.8 inspection.
2. Inspections outside of normal business hours, per hour (minimum charge – two hours).
3. Inspections for which no fee is specifically indicated, per hour (minimum charge – one-half hour).
4. Additional plan review required by changes, additions or revisions to plans or to plans for which an initial review has been completed (minimum charge – one-half hour).
